The Indian National Song

VANDEMATARAM

The song Vande Mataram composed in Sanskrit by Bankim Chandra Chatterjee was a source of inspiration to the people in their struggle for freedom. The song first appeared in his book 'Anandamath' published in 1882 amid fears of a ban by the British Raj, though the song itself was actually written six years prior in 1876.

- It shall not be used as a receptacle of anything.
- When damaged or soiled, it shall be destroyed as a whole in private.

A BRIEF HISTORY

St. Peter's Inter College, Rohta was founded and administered by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Pvt. Ltd., through its educational Society, the Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Education Society, Wazirpura Road, Agra, a Registered Charitable and Educational Society, It is a private unaided, Christian Minority Institution established in 2021 under the Article 30(1) of the Indian Constitution. School is affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi.

The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Agra is an entity which consists of Lay Roman Catholics, Roman Catholic religious, Roman Catholic priests and the Archbishop, being the Roman Catholic religious head.

Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Agra not only looks after the spiritual needs of the Catholics but also does many other forms of social service for the well-being of its community and other communities without any differences of religion, caste, creed and colour. Imparting holistic education is its principal area of social service.

God created the world, and the human beings equal in His sight. All have the same dignity whether one is rich or poor, black or white, whatever the name, caste or clan. So we have to love one another, respect one's as well as others dignity, show mercy, work for peace and just society, which will lead to the establishment of God's kingdom on Earth. That is the vision and mission of the Church. The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Agra, works towards the fulfilment this vision. School is one of the agents to achieve this end or goal.

And with this vision, the Roman Catholic Church establishes educational institutions through its educational society. St. Peter's Inter College, Rohta, is one such Institution where we cherish and treasure these policies and philosophy.

Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Education Society is governed by the members of the Governing Body.

Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Education Society has established many schools in the diocese of Agra, which consist of many civil districts of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan which includes Agra, Mathura, Firozabad, Shikohabad, Etah, Kasganj, Hathras, Aligarh, Etawah, Auraiya, Bastar, Bharatpur, Badaun, Bulandshahr, Kannauj, Dholpur, Farukhabad, Kiraoli, Mainpuri, Gautam Budh Nagar etc.

As a part of the expansion of the educational services to serve the people of Agra, it established St. Peter's Inter College at Rohta.

His Grace the Most Rev. Dr. Albert D'Souza entrusted the work of looking for suitable land to Rev. Fr. Paul Thannickal. The then Principal of St. Peter's College in 2014. After searching and sifting through many pieces of land for three years, and taking into consideration the cost and financial conditions, the Society purchased the land at Rohta, with the help of Rev. Fr. Sebastian Panthaladi, the incharge of the Diocesan properties; Rev. Fr. George Paul, Diocesan Director of Education and Mr. John Paul, a Catholic lay leader, in the year 2017.

Rev. Fr. Paul Thannickal, then Principal of St. Peter's College, Agra was officially made the incharge of Rohta Mission in April 2019. He started the construction with the laying down of the foundation stone by the Most Rev. Dr. Albert D' Souza, in the presence of Rev. Msgr. Joe Thykkattil, then Bishop elect of Gwalior, and other priests of Agra Archdiocese on June 20, 2019. The School received Affiliation for Nursery to VIII from Basic Education Department, Agra in 2023 and NOC for State Government in 2024 and provisional affiliation from CISCE in 2026, for ICSE (X) examinations.

CATHOLIC EDUCATION POLICY

Aims and Objectives:

1. The school aims at imparting quality education to the children, without any distinction of caste, creed, colour, social status etc. The focus is on enhancing all-round development of students.
2. We further aim at forming the youth of tomorrow in the value of hard work, honesty and universal brotherhood.
3. To train the students to be deeply rooted in Indian culture with a global outlook and capable of facing the challenges of modern life.
4. To familiarize the students with the values contained in the Indian Constitution.
5. To work and serve all in the true Christian spirit of love.
6. To reach out and to work with all people of goodwill for the basic values of Truth, Love, Justice, Equality, National Integration and Communal Harmony.
7. To educate our children to grow into integrated human beings by helping them to have a proper relationship with God, others and the environment, through spiritual, moral, physical, intellectual and emotional development and formation of character of the students by inculcating moral principles and values.
8. To inculcate in our students values such as love, acceptance, forgiveness justice, sharing and respect for all and to build up a healthy environment.
9. To have a preferential option for the poor and the oppressed so that they experience their human dignity and their integration into the mainstream of society.
10. To respect all religions and cultures of our country and to strive to achieve unity in diversity as part of God's plan for humanity.

11. To foster community spirit at all levels and to create a climate of participation and collaboration giving all our partners- staff, students and parents - a sense of belonging, commitment and responsibility.
12. To work together for common goals with like-minded institutions and organizations in the neighbourhood.
13. To promote family life so as to enable our students to face the challenges of growing into responsible adults and to prepare them for a meaningful, healthy and happy family life.

Academic Structure and Evaluation System

1. The academic session is from April to March; it is divided into two terms along with Unit Test/Class Test/Terminal Examination.
2. The first term is from April to September.
3. The second term is from October to March.

ADMISSION

1. Although Christian Minority Institutions are meant primarily for Christian, we do admit children of different castes, creeds and religions. New admissions are given on the basis of the availability of seats by draw of lots.
2. Normally admissions Open to Nursery Class. Those seeking admission should be 3 years of age on the 1st April of the year of admission.
3. Application for admission/Request form should be accompanied by authentic documents containing the child's date of birth.
4. We accept only Corporation/Municipality/ Baptism Certificate and Nursing Home Certificate. Affidavit or Kundali will not be accepted. Date of birth once registered, will not be altered at any cost.

ADMISSION TO CLASSES HAND ABOVE

1. The Transfer Certificate countersigned by education authority is a must for admission to Classes II and above.
2. The Transfer Certificate of a pupil coming from outside Uttar Pradesh must be countersigned by proper authorities irrespective of the Class into which admission is sought.
3. Admission is given on the basis of Entrance Test and on the availability of seats.
4. Irrespective of the time of admission, fee will be charged from the beginning of the academic session.
5. No pupil will be admitted in any Class higher than that for which the transfer certificate shows him to be qualified, nor will he be granted out of turn promotions.

WITHDRAWAL

1. The application for Transfer Certificate should be made in writing by the parent or guardian along with a fee of Rs. 100/-; the same will be issued only after three days from the date of receipt of the application.
2. A month's notice in writing is required before a student can be withdrawn; in lieu of such a notice, an additional fee of one month may be deposited. No such notice is acceptable during the College vacation; and in case of a withdrawal at this time, the fees must be paid up to the end of the term.
3. No certificate will be issued if there are dues pending.
4. Any request for counter signature should be made at the time of withdrawal; no such request will be catered to after one month of the issue of the Transfer Certificate.

5. Any student dismissed from the College on disciplinary ground shall have the same mentioned in his/her Transfer Certificate.

GUIDELINES FOR THE STUDENTS

Dear Students:

- a. Be polite and gentlemanly everywhere.
 - b. Be honest and truthful, and stand for values whatever be the cost.
 - c. Accept cheerfully whatever responsibility is given, difficulties with courage and determination.
 - d. Be courteous to the officials in the playground and take part in games in true sportsman spirit.
 - e. Greet your parents, teachers and elders whenever you meet them.
 - f. Have proper haircut at all times; avoid long hair, long nails and other modern fashionable styles.
 - g. Respect your own property, that of the College, as well as those belonging to others.
 - h. Be punctual and regular in coming to the College.
 - i. Be bold to say no when asked to do something that is basically wrong.
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1. Strict regularity, implicit obedience, courtesy in speech and conduct, cleanliness, of dress and person, are expected from every pupil. Students must strictly conform to the regulations laid down in this regard.
 2. Students are responsible for the conduct not only in the College, but also outside, any objectionable conduct outside the College makes them liable for disciplinary action, because such conduct would tarnish the reputation of the College.
 3. Any kind of damage done to the College property must be made good/compensated.
 4. No collection of any sort is to be made without the

explicit permission of the Principal.

5. Gifts to the members of the staff, or other expressions in their honour, are not allowed.
6. Students must speak English in the campus.
7. All students must possess a copy of the College calendar and it is to be brought to the College on all working days.
8. Late-comers and absentees will not be admitted without a proper explanation in writing from the parents.
9. Students must participate in the daily Assembly.
10. Leave of absence will be granted for genuine reasons if applied by the parents in advance.
11. Fines will be imposed by the Principal or the staff for irregularity, indiscipline, damage to the College property, improper uniform, violation of traffic rules etc.
12. Students are not to leave the College premises during school hours without the written permission of the Principal/Vice Principal/Headmistress.
13. Irregular attendance, insubordination, bad conduct, habitual lack of interest, behaviour, detrimental to the discipline and the moral tone of the College, repeated failure in tests or examinations, are sufficient reasons, singly or collectively, to expel a student from the College.
14. Every student must be present on the following days - Republic Day, Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Principal's Day, Teacher's Day, Children's Day, Annual Day and Sports Day for the school activities. Absence on these days without prior permission from the Principal will invite disciplinary action.
15. College holds no responsibility for the loss of money, books, articles of clothing, or other valuables; students are exhorted not to bring excess money and valuables into the campus.

16. Lost and found articles are to be deposited in the College office.
17. Disobedience to the clearly expressed orders of the Principal, will lead to the ward's dismissal without any warning. The same applies to moral turpitude, defacing of the College property and premises, and defiance of the authorities.
18. Students are not excused from games and physical activities without a written note from a qualified doctor; on the other hand they are highly encouraged to come for games every evening and also to take part in cultural and sports competitions.
19. Do not bring colours and throw them on any person within the school premises during the season of Holi; the same applies to the bringing of crackers and bursting them in the campus. Anyone indulging in these will be severely dealt with.
20. Whoever brings or causes to be brought in electronic form any material which contains sexually explicit act or conduct shall be punishable.
21. Whoever brings or causes to be brought in electronic form, any material which is luscious or appeals to the prurient interest, or if its effect is such as to tend to deprave and corrupt persons or read, see or hear the matter contained or embodied in it shall be punishable.
22. Pupils are forbidden to bring crackers, explosives, harmful instruments and other dangerous material to the College.

SYLLABUS/EXAMINATION/PROMOTION

1. Subject like Moral Science, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, History, Geography, Mathematics, Science, Economics, Commerce, Accountancy, Computer Science, Art, Physical Training, Handicraft, Music, General Knowledge and extra-curricular activities

including yoga are taught according to the grades of the pupils.

2. Students are to offer only those subjects regularly in the College, that are provided for in the approved scheme of studies.
3. The progress report will be shown only to the parents or guardians after every term examination; it can be withheld for non-payment of College dues.
4. A student who is absent from an examination, for any reason whatsoever, will not be re-examined.
5. Willful breach of the regulations of the examinations is punishable with immediate expulsion from the examination, and the subsequent cancellation of the paper. Those who resort
6. Willful breach of the regulations of the examinations is punishable with immediate expulsion from the examination, and the subsequent cancellation of the paper. Those who resort to unfair practices will be expelled from the examination room, and will be refused admission to subsequent examinations, and even be expelled from the College.
7. Failure or absence from an examination excludes the student from being reckoned for the order of merit.
8. For promotion, a student must obtain a clear pass in all subjects. The students of Classes I to XII must secure in every subject 33% of marks.
9. No student will be allowed to write the theory papers if he/she fails to complete the practical work: e.g. GK Diary: Science practical, projects etc.
10. If a student does not have 75% attendance of the total working days in each term, he/she will not be allowed to take the terminal examinations.
11. Taking all the term exams is compulsory for promotion.
12. Promotion once refused will not be reconsidered.
13. Failure in a Class is a clear sign of laxity. Hence, only

under extra-ordinary circumstances will a student be allowed to repeat a Class.

LIBRARY RULES

1. Maintain absolute silence in the library. Every student must read books from the library.
2. Every student will have one non-transferable library card. Books are issued and collected back during the library period only. A book is issued for one week, and may be reissued for another week only.
3. In case of loss of the library card, one will be issued at the cost of Rs. 100/-.
4. Every student should return the card before the academic year ends.
5. The loss or damage to the book will incur a fine amounting to the double cost of the book.
6. Every student is expected to follow strictly the guidelines given by the librarian.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. These rules and regulations are laid down in the best interest of your child. Kindly read them and assist your son to observe them diligently.
2. Give your wholehearted and willing cooperation in all matters pertaining to the education of your son. Please abide by the judgement and decision of the Principal and the staff.
3. Supervise your sons studies at homes; send him to College regularly and help him/her to do his College work neatly.
4. Do look for the operational reports, comments and complaints from teachers entered in the diary of your ward; sign them as proof that you have seen them and also sign other relevant documents when required.
5. You are recommended to call on the Principal at least once in each term so as to ascertain from him/her what has been the conduct and progress of your son/daughter.
6. Complaints, if any, should be made in writing to the Principal, and not to the teachers. We do not act on anonymous letters.
7. As per the government rule, the date of birth of a student, once entered in our records, cannot be changed under any circum-stances.
8. The student who does not rejoin the school within three days after the commencement of a term or after a major vacation shall be removed from the rolls unless leave has been previously applied for and sanctioned by the Principal.
9. In case of absence for more than three days on medical grounds, a Medical Certificate must be produced. The Medical Certificate should bear the rubber stamp of the doctor with his registration number. In case of necessity, the College has the right to have the child re-examined by a doctor acceptable to the College.

10. Do not forget to submit Medical Certificate if your child is absent on medical grounds. Medical leave is granted not for less than three days at a time.
11. If a student continues to be absent for a month without the previous written permission of the Principal his/her name will be struck off the rolls. In case of re-admission, all the fees will be charged afresh.
12. No tuitions are allowed. Hence, encourage children to form the habit of self-study; to clarify the doubts from their own subject teachers in the school and to avoid having parallel classes in the so-called tuition centres.
13. Children are your wealth; students are our pride. As you love and care for them, so do we intend the best for them. Hence, the staff and parents should have mutual trust and confidence. Never let sparks turn into fire.
14. Very often students bring to school such items that have nothing to do with studies, e.g. mobiles, Pokemon, tattoos etc. Parents must refrain the children from bringing such things to the College.
15. It is a matter of deep concern that parents send children suffering from infectious diseases to attend classes or examinations. Such conduct may lead to an epidemic like situation in the school. Please remember that we are responsible for the welfare of others. Hence, take note of the quarantine period recommended for the following infectious ailments. Chickenpox three weeks, measles and mumps two weeks, conjunctivitis one week.

PARENTS PLEASE NOTE

The College can do a lot for your child, but it cannot do everything. The home is the place where the child gets his/her first education and training. It is the chief place where character is formed and developed. Education only

enhances the growth of personality and helps to awaken the dormant qualities that are in them. So your cooperation is very necessary.

You are requested to help your children with their homework, prepare a timetable for their personal study and see that they follow it religiously. Our aim is to develop in our students strong attitude of self-reliance and confidence with personal and concentrated study habits, to stimulate in them original thinking. Therefore, we would like you to discourage your children from going for private tuitions, which will make them lazy, irresponsible, indisciplined and dependent.

TIPS TO STUDY

1. Take first the subject you most dislike, once you have done this, rest of your work will be easy.
2. Do not hesitate to ask your teacher or your clever companions, things you do not grasp clearly. Never leave difficulties uncleared as this will put you in greater difficulties later.
3. To make sure that you have understood something thoroughly use these tricks:
 - Pretend that you are explaining the lesson to others to see if you can do it well.
 - Make yourself your own teacher and question yourself and answer honestly (don't cheat).
4. Do not continue working when you are tired, walk around the garden, or talk to a friend or have some other pleasant interruption, but only long enough to refresh you for your lessons and not tending to waste time.
5. Get enough physical exercise every day, it keeps the mind fresh.

6. Do not cut down necessary sleep in order to study. It may harm your health. Pray often to God to help you to make progress in your studies.
7. Never omit the lesson or homework assigned, if you do, it is like missing a train that you can never catch afterwards.
8. Daily revise the work done in the class, and make sure that you have understood everything clearly and thoroughly.
9. If memory work is assigned, learn it overnight and repeat it, first thing, in the morning.
10. Always note down in your diary the work that is assigned for the next day.
11. Revise at the end of the week all that was taught during the week.
12. If you don't keep high expectations in front of yourself, you will probably settle for something less. High expectations lead to high performance, and low expectations to low performance.
13. The College expect your children:
 - * To Not only do their homework but also think on how they do it.
 - * Continuously formulate statements about how they study with the aim of working to improve their study skills.
14. The more you can analyse your own thoughts and actions, the more controlled you can take over your lives, and that's the real point of school; to help you to be self-reliant.
